The Wistom of the Sight of the Child

Since the death of Duke Jean III ten years earlier (April 30, 1341), Brittany, fault

of direct heir is torn apart by the War of Succession. On one side Jean de Monfort, supported by England, on the other Charles de Blois working for the attachment of Brittany to the kingdom of France.

Then Brittany finds itself divided into two camps. The war begins.

Ploërmel is subject to Jean de Montfort and Josselin remains faithful to Charles de Blois.

- 1351: In Ploërmel, for Jean de Montfort, a garrison is formed commanded by Bembro, captain of the stronghold of Ploërmel and in Josselin, for Charles de Blois, a garrison commanded by Jean de Beaumanoir, captain of Josselin and Marshal of Brittany.



The garrison of Bembro plunders (robs) the country of Ploërmel. So Beaumanoir goes to find Bembro and tells him

"We must put an end to this way of plundering the people... The peasants sow wheat and give us food" God be the judge! Let's choose 30 or 40 champions!

I accept" said Bembro.

On March 26 of this year 1351, in front of a considerable crowd gathered around the oak of Mid-Way,

The stage is now set for one of the greatest feats of arms in Breton history!



- Jean de Beaumanoir chooses "30 good Bretons".
- Bembro chooses: 20 English, 6 German, 4 Breton.
- The two troops face each other and retreat, then rush at each other: they fight "in a heap".
- 2 brettons are killed, 3 are wounded and taken prisoner.
- We stop the fight to rest. Then it is the resumption of the fight. Bembro is killed. Crokart replaces him. Four of his soldiers are killed. The earth is red with blood. Beaumanoir is injured. He is thirsty, he asks for a drink.

One of the soldiers replies: "Drink your blood, Beaumanoir, and your thirst will pass you! »

So Beaumanoir throws himself on the English. (He still loses his blood.) Guillaume de Montauban jumps on his horse and strikes the English with great spear thrusts.

Beaumanoir's army won the victory.

The Bretons lose only 3 soldiers, the English lose 12. Those who remain are covered with enormous wounds and wounds. This combat remained famous during centuries and one said while speaking about a battle where one had fought well "one grabbed itself as with the Combat of Thirty".



The different Whallenges by Water 2:

Poulart Challenge - 8 years old:

Game in the form of a "5x5 contact game" on a 30m x 20m field. Each club or group can only register a maximum of 2 teams. (teams of 5 + 4 substitutes maximum).

Lande Challenge - 10 years:

Game in the form of "5x5 contact game" on a 30m x 25m field. Each club or group can only register a maximum of 2 teams (teams of 5 + 4 substitutes maximum).

Serraut Challenge - 12 years old:

Game in the form of "10x10 re, game at X" on a 56m x 45m field. Each club or group can only register a maximum of 2 teams. (teams of 10 + 10 substitutes maximum).

Rochefort Challenge - 14 years old:

Game in the form of "7x7 contact game" on a 56m x 45m field. Each club or group can only register a maximum of 2 teams. (teams of 7 + 6 substitutes maximum).
